Explanatory Notes

This Notice is made to provide authorisation for licensees to continue to 'rehabilitate injured, sick and orphaned protected animals' until the new expiry date of 30 June 2020. A new licence will therefore not be issued for the coming July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 year.

This Notice does not vary the activities or classes of native animals authorised under each licence, or any licence conditions that are not included above in this notice.

The holder of the Licence may appeal to the Land and Environment Court against this licence variation within 28 days of being given notice of this variation.
